

# Essex Red Cross Presentation



The Provincial Grand Master visited the Essex Red Cross headquarters in Chelmsford on the 11<sup>th</sup> March to make the formal handover of keys of a new Ambulance which has been paid for by the Freemasons Grand Charity.
